- Fabricate per drawings and standard practices wire bundles and assemblies to include marking of wires, properly securing wires into bundles, and termination of wires into a variety of contacts and connectors.

- Operate ground support equipment e.g. power carts, etc. as required.

- Knowledgeable and experienced in using computerized aircraft maintenance programs and manuals.
- Have a broad, overall knowledge of other aircraft systems e.g. hydraulic, flight controls, etc. and major components.
